## The Haberdashers' Golf Day 2024 - Sunday 8th September 2024

We are excited to invite members of the Habs community to our annual Haberdashers' Golf Day. The 24<sup>th</sup> staging of the event will take place on Sunday 8<sup>th</sup> September 2024 at Porters Park Golf Club. Tee-times are from 2pm and supper and prize giving to follow at approximately 7.30pm. Entry fees will be £62 for adults and £45 for students. This will include 18 holes of competitive golf, a light supper and prizes.

Handicap certificates are not required but golfers should be capable of playing to a maximum handicap of 36. The day is open to students from all year groups at Haberdashers' Boys' and Girls' Schools, Old Haberdashers, parents and staff.

This year we hope to encourage a large field of golfers to compete for The Elstree Trophy, won in 2022 by Mr Andy Ward in his final time organising the event. Prizes will be awarded for nearest the pin, longest drive, and best parent and student combined score. Students will compete for trophies in both scratch and handicap categories, as usual. All other players will compete for The Elstree Trophy. As in recent years, official EGU handicaps will apply on the day on production of a current handicap certificate. Handicaps for all other players will be calculated according to the Callaway system, more details of which can be found at <a href="http://www.leaderboard.com/callaway.htm">http://www.leaderboard.com/callaway.htm</a>.
