Club FAQs:

What is the process for signing my son up to clubs?

Reception: **Co-curricular for Reception commences in Spring term, to allow time for 'settling in'.** Boys make club choices from the published programme with parents (at home), an expression of wish form is published to parents. Responses are collated and places are allocated.

Year 1 - 2: Boys make club choices from the published programme and register their interest via SOCS sign-up with parents at home. Responses are collated and places are allocated.

Please note: Relevant categories in SOCS: Pre-Prep Clubs, Pre-Prep Paid Clubs and Prep Sports Clubs

Year 3 - 6: Boys make club choices from the published programme with parents (at home), make a note of their club choices in their homework diary and register their interest via SOCS sign-up in school, usually during an assigned form time. Responses are collated and places allocated.

Please note: Relevant categories in SOCS: Prep Clubs, Prep Paid Clubs and Prep Sports Clubs

How can I view the clubs programme?

The co-curricular programme is published to parents termly before the beginning of the new term. Thereafter, it can be viewed on the Prep and Pre-Prep Information pages on Firefly.

How do I sign-in to SOCS?

Reception: Do not have SOCS accounts. An expression of wish form is published to parents.

Year 1 - 2: Sign-in details for your son's account will be published by way of a sticker in the front of his home/school message book.

Year 3 – 6: Most boys will already know their login/password details and be able to login to SOCS.

Boys can speak to their form teachers, during the school day, who can assist with any club queries they may have and help with sign-up if required.

How many clubs can my son sign-up for?

Reception - Year 2: Boys are expected to attend a minimum of 1 club each week and a maximum of 2 lunchtime clubs per week. Boys are not permitted to attend more than 1 club during lunchtime on any given day

Year 3 - 6: Pupils are free to choose the number of clubs they wish to attend although we would suggest a minimum of 4 per week split over lunchtimes and after school for Year 3 specifically.

How will I know which clubs my son has been allocated? Can you send me confirmation of my son's club choices?

FROM 5PM FRIDAY 12 SEPT:

Rec 1 - 6: Boys confirmed clubs' allocation/schedules are available on SOCS via the Firefly dashboard (<Quick links><SOCS><Pupil>).

My Son wasn't allocated all his club choices. What happens if a club is oversubscribed?

If your son is not allocated a club for which he has registered an interest, the club is oversubscribed and he has been placed on a waiting list, you will be contacted if a place becomes available.

Do I need to sign-up termly? Can my son be automatically re-enrolled - for a club with a progressive skill i.e. Judo and Fencing?

Music clubs are a yearly commitment, there is no need to sign-up termly. Except for 'invite only' clubs, boys must sign-up termly to all other clubs.

Why can't I access the club payment my Evolve account?

Evolve payment is not utilised in this way for club payments – you do not need to set-up an Evolve account. An Evolve payment link will be sent to you for payment purposes.

Please, do not make payment prior to receiving the payment link, as further adjustments may be made prior to the link being shared.

When will I receive the payment link?

Typically, payment links will be shared in week 3-4 of each term, once club choices have been allocated and all clubs have been running for at least 2 weeks. Payment is requested for each club your son attends for the term, in advance.

What happens if my son's paid club session is cancelled or missed due to a school trip?

If a session is cancelled by the club provider or the school and a 'make-up session' is not feasible, a refund will be processed for that session. Parents are not charged for sessions during a school residential or day trip, this is reflected in the fee as charged.

What if my son signs up to a paid club, tries it and decides he doesn't want to attend anymore or there is a clash with another activity after he attends for some sessions?

Up to half-term, you will only be charged for the number of sessions your son has attended. **Please note:** Changes cannot be accommodated in the 2nd half of the term, except in exceptional circumstances (on a case-by-case basis), as the provider will have billed the school for the term based on the number of pupils that are attending at this point. Should your son's withdrawal be approved, if you have already paid the termly fee at the point of your son's withdrawal from the club, the remaining unused session amount will be refunded to you.

From where do I pick-up my son from an after-school club:

Please ensure that your son is aware of his pick-up arrangements and that a note has been made in his homework diary/message book.

All boys must sign-out with the supervising member of staff before leaving.

Clubs held in:

- Prep School: Pick-up from Prep School Reception.
- Girls School: Pick-up from Girls' Junior School Reception
(Year 1–2: ASC is NOT available to boys attending a club at the Girl's School)
- Medburn Sports Centre: Pick-up from Prep School Reception **ONLY**
- Authorised collectors: Usual rules apply.
