This year marks the second successful year of joint music at Habs, a collaboration that began in September 2025 and has already seen our musical standards soar as music is taught and performed together across our shared campus. Almost all senior school ensembles are now fully joint, establishing Habs as one of the most vibrant, dynamic and inclusive music schools in the country.
