Coach Travel for New Joiners

Congratulations on your child's place at Habs from September 2025. The following information is provided to help you book transportation for your child to and from school.

Tickets for regular travel

If you wish to apply for a place on the coach service from the Autumn Term you can now do so via the online form by [clicking here](#). Priority is given to new students, and we encourage families to complete their request early.

All requests to join the coach service for September are processed in the order of receipt and tickets are sold subject to availability.

If you are unsure of your child's travel pattern at the start of the Autumn Term, please complete the form for all possible days and times you may wish to use the service. If you then find that during the first 2 weeks of the new term you need to make some adjustments to fit your child's co-curricular activities, we can assist with these changes. Adding travel days and times can be more challenging than reducing travel as our routes can become busy.
